Restaurants	Food delivery and takeaway can remain operational for consumption off premises.
Cafes, including workplace canteens	Workplace canteens may remain open where— (a) there is no practical alternative for staff at that workplace to obtain food; and (b) all reasonable measures are taken to ensure that a distance of 2 metres is maintained between any person using the canteen.

Bars and nightclubs, including bars in hotels or members' clubs	
Retail	
All retail with notable exceptions	Exceptions are listed below – however these businesses if operating must comply with the prescribed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Supermarkets and other food shops, Off-licences and licensed shops selling alcohol (including breweries), Newsagents, Home, building supplies and hardware shops, petrol stations, Car repair and MOT services, Bicycle shops, Taxi or vehicle hire businesses, Banks, building societies, credit unions, short term loan providers and cash points Post offices, Funeral Directors, Launderettes and dry cleaners, Dental services, opticians, audiology services, chiropody, chiropractors, osteopaths and other medical Veterinary surgeons and pet shops, Agricultural supplies shops, Storage and distribution facilities, including delivery drop off points, Car parks, Public toilets.

Hotels, BnBs, campsites and boarding houses, Other holiday accommodation (including holiday apartments, hostels and boarding houses).	Where people live in these as interim abodes whilst their primary residence is unavailable they may continue to do so. Key workers can continue to stay in hotels or similar where required.
Caravan parks/sites for commercial uses	Where people live permanently in caravan parks or are staying in caravan parks as interim abodes where their primary residence is not available, they may continue to do so.

Community centres, youth centres and similar	Facilities may remain open for the purpose of hosting essential voluntary or public services, such as food banks or homeless services, and where all reasonable measures are taken to ensure that a distance of 2 metres is maintained between every person on the premises while those services are provided. We will do everything to support vulnerable people who are without a network of friends and families.
	If all reasonable measures are taken to ensure a distance of 2 metres is maintained between every person in the place of worship, the place may be used:

Places of worship	<p>(a) for funerals,</p> <p>(b) to broadcast (without a congregation) an act of worship or funeral (whether over the internet or as part of a radio or television broadcast), or</p> <p>(c) to provide essential voluntary services or, upon the request of the Welsh Ministers or a local authority, urgent public services (including the provision of food banks or other support for the homeless or vulnerable people, blood donation sessions or support in an emergency) and where all reasonable measures are taken to ensure that a distance of 2 metres is maintained between every person on the premises while those services are provided.</p>
Crematoria	If all reasonable measures are taken to ensure a distance of 2 metres is maintained between every person in the crematorium, the crematorium may open to members of the public for funerals or burials (and to broadcast a funeral or burial whether over the internet or otherwise).
Cinemas, theatres and concert halls	Live streaming of a performance by a small group could be permissible with social distancing observed.
